STUDENT FUND-RAISING ACTIVITIES

1. Each school support organization planning to participate in fund-raising activities should notify the principal of plans for raising and disbursing funds.
2. Fund-raising activities should be confined to non-instructional time. Teacher and administrator time should be kept to a minimum.
3. The quality of the product and the reputation of the firm should be considered in all fund-raising activities.
4. All funds raised by school and school-related groups should be placed in the appropriate administrative account and a written report filed with the principal's office for public record.
5. Student participation in fundraising activities will be voluntary.

Major, all-school fund-raisers should be limited to one per year, not including in-house fund-raising projects. In-house projects include such activities as pictures, bake sales, fun nights, garage sales, dinners, etc.
