**SCHOOL GROUNDS' REGULATIONS
Including Mile Lane**

The Ipswich School Committee has adopted the following regulations, to apply with respect to those lots under their respective care, custody and control:

All playing fields/open areas on school property are under the jurisdiction of the Ipswich School Committee and subject to the following conditions:

1. No person shall operate a recreational vehicle or snow vehicle, as defined in Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 90B, Section 20, as amended, upon any land under the care, custody and control of the Ipswich School Committee. Lots to which this regulation shall be applicable are:

2. A proper written permit to use a playing field/open area must first be received from the Athletic Department at Ipswich High School. Group(s) having the necessary permit(s) have sole permission to use a particular playing field/open area for the length of time designated on the permit(s). Any group(s) in violation of this policy will not be allowed to use available playing fields/open areas in the future.
3. No alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs are allowed at any time prior, during following use of available playing fields/open areas. **NO USE OF TOBACCO PRODUCTS IS ALLOWED AT ANY TIME.**
4. No golf is allowed at any time.
5. No walking of horses or horseback riding is allowed at any time.
6. Walking of dogs and cats is allowed, but proper care must be taken by the owner to clean up after their animal to assure that the playing field/open area does not pose any health/safety risk to those using the facilities at the time and/or in the future.

7. All trash/debris shall be placed in appropriate receptacles prior to leaving the playing fields/open areas.

Failure to comply with any or all of these conditions will result in total loss of facility use privileges, and may lead to legal action taken against violators.

8. Traffic regulations for the Ipswich Public Schools grounds shall be as follows:
 - (A) For the Middle/High School: Vehicles shall not exceed 15 miles per hour from the intersection of School and High Streets to the school property boundary line at School Street. This includes any and all access roads, driveways, or parking lots on school property.
 - (B) For the Elementary Schools: Vehicles shall not exceed the posted speed limit. This includes any and all access roads, driveways or parking lots on school property.
 - (C) At All Schools: Drivers must obey all traffic signs, rules and regulations on the property, including but not limited to "Stop", "One Way", "Yield", "Fire Lane", "Tow Zone", "Handicap Parking," "Restricted Parking," "Bus Safety Regulations" and any temporary signs posted.
 - (D) At All Schools: Drivers must obey all pavement and curbing markings directing the movement of traffic and restricting parking.
